
Everything you need to know before going through airport security

f you are planning to travel by air, it's important to know what to expect when you go through airport security. This essay aims to provide you with some tips to help you prepare for the security screening and know what to avoid to hasten the process.

You will learn about what clothing and shoes to wear, how to pack liquids and gels, and how to handle larger containers of liquid medications and medical supplies. You'll also find out why you shouldn't count on TSA PreCheck. By following these tips, you can make your next airport security screening a breeze.

Wear clothing and shoes without metallic





embellishment: This will help you avoid setting off the metal detector. Be ready to remove your belt if it has a metal buckle. Tuck large metal jewelry pieces into your carry-on bag before you go through the security checkpoint. Put change and keys into a plastic bin when you arrive at the checkpoint. If you have body piercings, either remove them before you go through security or resign yourself to a pat-down screening.

Take your time removing and putting on shoes: You will have to take your shoes off at the security checkpoint and put them into a plastic bin for screening unless you are over age 75. Several thousand humans walk through the metal detectors each day, so you will probably want to protect yourself from germs by wearing socks.

Pack liquids and gels in a one-quart plastic bag: All liquid and gel items must be in 100 milliliter (3.4



ounces) or smaller containers. Every liquid and gel product you carry into the passenger compartment must meet this requirement and fit into a single, one-quart zip-closure clear plastic bag. If you must bring larger liquid or gel items, you will have to place them in your checked baggage unless they are medically necessary. Gel-like food items such as peanut butter, jello, and pumpkin pie will be confiscated, so it is best to leave them at home. Natural powders may need extra screening. Consider putting powders into your checked bag unless they are medically necessary.

Keep larger containers of liquid medications, nutrition drinks and



medical supplies separate from other **liquids and gels:** You can bring prescription liquid medications through security. You can also bring medically-necessary water, juice, and other "liquid nutrition" as well as frozen liquids or gels that you will use to cool medical items. Prosthetics and medical items are also permitted. The catch? Everything must be screened in some way. Tell the security screeners what medical and disability-related items you have with you and ask them to screen the items visually if X-rays will harm them. (Important: Never put prescription medications in checked baggage. Hand carry them or mail them ahead.).

Don't count on TSA PreCheck: Not all airports have TSA PreCheck lanes open all the time, and not all areas of every airport have PreCheck lanes available. For example, C Pier at Baltimore / Washington Thurgood Marshall International Airport does not have a PreCheck lane, and PreCheck lanes at the other three piers are not always open. We hope these tips help you prepare for your next airport security screening. Safe travels!

Binance Ceases NGN Operations

ollowing the rapid depreciation of the value of the Naira [NGN], the Federal Government cracked down on online crypto exchange platforms with Binance being the most prominent, with the aim of arresting the decline of the Naira and to avert what it believes to be manipulation of the foreign exchange market and illegal movement of funds. Supposedly related to these crackdowns were reports from various outlets that the government had detained at least two senior executives of Binance following the ban on the website.

Following reports of the arrest of the executives, Binance themselves released a statement to users, advising them to withdraw their NGN off the platform or to trade NGN assets and convert them into crypto. The statement from Binance, published on the 5th of March, 2024, reads as follows:

"Users are encouraged to withdraw NGN, trade their NGN assets, or convert NGN into crypto prior to the discontinuation of these NGN services. From 2024-03-08 08:00 (UTC), any remaining NGN balances in users' Binance accounts will be immediately converted to USDT based on the conversation rate below.

Binance will not support deposits of NGN after 2024-03-05 14:00 (UTC). Withdrawals of NGN will not be supported after 2024-03-08 06:00 (UTC). After 2024-03-08 08:00 (UTC), Binance will convert any remaining NGN

balances in users' Spot and Funding wallets into USDT on behalf of users at a ratio of 1 USDT = 1,515.13 NGN. Please note that the conversion rate is calculated based on the average closing price of the USDT/NGN trading pair on Binance Spot in the last seven days.

The conversion may take approximately up to 24 hours or longer. USDT tokens will be credited to users' Spot wallets thereafter, and users can confirm receipt of the tokens via the Convert History page. If users hold less than 0.00000001 USDT worth of NGN in their Spot and Funding wallets, they will each receive 0.000000001 USDT in their Spot wallets after the conversion."



Based on this statement, it appears as though it will still be possible for users to deal in other tokens on the platform, just not anything to do with the NGN—although, it remains a point of speculation that the FG could still opt to permanently ban all activity to do with the platform.

It should be noted that in recent months, Binance have been on the receiving end of sanctions and restrictions from other governments, most notably the

governments of the United States of America, Iran, Iraq, and North Korea largely due to domestic financial restrictions or requirements. and international sanctions. Despite this restriction of crypto services, as at the time of writing, the NGN/ USD conversion rate is currently still reported at \$1 = N1.590.669 and it remains to be seen whether or not the coming months might see the Naira stabilize and justify the decision made by the Federal Government.





BeReal: The Fast-Growing Social App Championing Authenticity

nter BeReal, a photo-sharing app revolutionising the social media landscape, emphasising genuine, unfiltered moments. While it may not be on everyone's radar yet, its popularity is soaring, with a remarkable 315% increase in active monthly users this year, as reported by Apptopia. Launched in early 2020 by a French entrepreneur, BeReal has attracted a surge of users, with over 65% joining just this year. Unlike its counterparts, BeReal promotes authenticity by inviting users to share real-time glimpses into their lives, free from the façade of filters and edits.

With no filters or editing tools, BeReal encourages users to embrace the raw and genuine aspects of their daily lives. Whether it's a messy hair day or a mundane view of a rainy parking lot, BeReal celebrates the beauty of imperfection.

The app's concept is refreshingly straightforward. Once a day, users receive

a notification prompting them to "BeReal." Within two minutes, they must snap and post a photo of their current moment, no matter how ordinary. Adding to its allure, the notification arrives randomly, injecting an element of spontaneity into the user experience.

Upon clicking the daily notification, users are prompted to capture a snapshot of their surroundings within the app, along with a simultaneous rear-facing selfie. Both images are shared instantly, with users having the option to retake and post them at their convenience.

While BeReal permits users to post photos later in the day, it reveals the time elapsed since the original notification, emphasising spontaneity over planned content. This unique feature holds users accountable for their authenticity, fostering a community built on genuine connections rather than curated perfection.



Airlines record surging cargo demand on a global scale

Across the globe, positive momentum in air cargo demand has set an optimistic tone for the industry, reflecting resilience and adaptability to changing global dynamics.

In January 2024, African airlines witnessed a commendable surge in air cargo volumes, marking a 17.0% increase, a significant recovery from December's performance slump (-1.2%). The region's carriers particularly thrived on the Africa-Asia trade lane, contributing to the overall improvement.

The capacity in January also showed a robust growth of 19.4%, surpassing January 2023 levels.

This positive trend extended globally, as per data released by the International Air

Transport Association (IATA).

The report revealed a robust start to 2024 in the global air cargo markets. The total demand, measured in cargo tonne-kilometers (CTKs), surged by an impressive 18.4% compared to January 2023 (19.8% for international operations). This marked the highest annual growth in cargo tonne-kilometers since the summer season of 2021.

Capacity, measured in available cargo tonne-kilometres (ACTKs), showed a substantial increase of 14.6% compared to January 2023 (18.2% for international operations). This was largely attributed to the growth in belly capacity, with international belly capacity experiencing a remarkable 25.8% year-on-year increase.

role in driving air cargo demand above growth in both trade and production. However, he acknowledged the looming uncertainty regarding China's economic slowdown, which will be a focal point of discussion at the upcoming IATA World Cargo Symposium in Hong Kong.

The strong growth in air cargo demand outpaced trade and production, with notable factors in the operating environment:

Global cross-border trade experienced a 1.0% increase in December compared to the previous month, although showing a marginal decline year-on-year.

January's manufacturing output Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) indicated expansion for the first time in eight months, reaching 50.3. However, the new export orders PMI, while showing improvement at 48.8, remained below the critical 50 threshold, suggesting a continuing, albeit decelerating, decline in global exports.

Inflation in major economies eased, reaching 3.1% in the US and EU and 2.1% in Japan. China's negative inflation rate of -0.8%, the lowest since 2009, raised concerns about an economic slowdown.

Analyzing regional performances:
Asia-Pacific airlines recorded a remarkable
24.6% increase in air cargo volumes in January
2024. Carriers in the region benefited from
substantial growth on three major trade lanes:
Africa-Asia (+52.5%), Middle East-Asia (+29.5%),
and Europe-Asia (+27.5%).

North American carriers showed a 9.3% increase in cargo volumes, with improved performance on the North America-Asia and North America-Europe trade lanes. Capacity increased by 3.8%.

European carriers demonstrated a robust



performance with a 16.4% increase in air cargo volumes, particularly benefiting from growth in the within Europe market and the Europe-Asia route. Capacity increased by 12.5%. Middle Eastern carriers exhibited the strongest performance, recording a 25.9% year-on-year increase in cargo volumes.

This was driven by growth in the Middle East–Asia and Middle East–Europe markets. Capacity increased by 17.1%.

Latin American carriers experienced a notable 13.4% increase in cargo volumes compared to January 2023, with a capacity increase of 6.6%.

-Learn Airport Steps:





he long-awaited seguel to Denis Villeneuve's 2021 sci-fi epic arrived in theaters globally on the 1st of March, 2024 much to the delight of fans of both the prequel and of the Frank Herbert novel that started it all. With Villeneuve once again at the helm and featuring an all-star ensemble including the likes of Timothee Chalamet, Zendaya, Austin Butler, Josh Brolin, Javier Bardem, Rebecca Ferguson and Stellan Skarsgaard, Dune: Part Two is exactly what the world expected would be. 
While 2021's Dune was appraised by critics and audiences, there were those who believed the movie to be slow or very clearly acting as a setup for something else. In 2024's sequel however, Denis

Villeneuve holds nothing back and shows to the world exactly what was being set up. Picking up right where the first left off, Dune: Part Two continues the journey of Timothee Chalamet's Paul Atreides and Rebecca Ferguson's Lady Jessica on the desert planet of Arrakis, with their involvement with the planet's native Fremen putting the pieces in place for what is perhaps the grandest, epic battle to have come to theaters since The Battle of Helm's Deep from 2002's Lord of the Rings: The Two Towers. don't. Awaiting you in Dune: Part Two is a visual, artistic masterpiece indicative of the handwork and oversight of an auteur such as Villeneuve. An argument can be made that every scene in this movie, if captured as a still, is of sufficient enough invocative beauty to be displayed at the Louvre. And this movie is more than just eye-candy—powerful performances from its star-studded cast ensure that the characters most integral to the story carry some great nuance to them. All in all, this is one that will demand several rewatches of you, and will live long in the memory.


